

DESIGNATING A BEQUEST TO THE SALVATION ARMY

Organizational Structure

The Salvation Army World Service Office of The Salvation Army (SAWSO) is incorporated in the District of Columbia. Suggested Language for Designating a Bequest

*I give the sum of \$_____, or _____% of the residual of my estate, to The Salvation Army World Service Office. A bequest may be designated for a certain geographic area or program, in which case the gifting document must include language expressing the donor's wishes. For example: *The funds are to be used exclusively in, for, for the benefit of the (Country/program) located in (city/country).**

If the bequest is designated for a specific purpose, inclusion of the following language will help to ensure that the gift will always remain productive:

If at any time, in the judgment of the Board of Trustees of The Salvation Army World Service Office, the designated use of this bequest is no longer practical or appropriate, then the Board shall use the bequest to further the general purposes of The Salvation Army Service Office, giving consideration, where possible, to my special interest as described above.
